Project title Using Frogans as a medium, design a virtual cross-cultural trainer helping Western organizations get acquainted with Chinese business communication practices	
Project description <p>At the beginning of the 1990s, a medium for publishing content and services was introduced on the Internet: the World Wide Web. This medium suggests publishing content and services which involve text-based communication, long pages, and complex user interfaces.</p> <p>Today, a new medium for publishing content and services is being introduced on the Internet: Frogans. This medium suggests publishing content and services which involve visual communication, focused content, and natural interaction. Frogans enables a new kind of communication between end users and publishers of content and services. Frogans is not meant for publishing Web sites, but Frogans sites, a new kind of online site founded upon a different format.</p> <p>For an overview of the technology making up Frogans as a medium: https://www.frogans.org/en/resources/overview/access.html</p> <p>The Frogans technology is developed by the OP3FT, a Standards Developing Organization (SDO) based in France, with OP3FT China, the local branch of the OP3FT located in Beijing.</p> <p>The project consists in designing a virtual cross-cultural trainer using Frogans as a medium. The virtual cross-cultural trainer will help Western organizations bridge the cultural gap between Western and Chinese business communication practices. The first trainees will be members of the OP3FT team based in France.</p> <p>Three deliverables are expected from students (in English):</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A general design of the virtual cross-cultural trainer including a description of the data sources used and technical considerations (hosting, API used if any...). 2. A detailed design of the virtual cross-cultural trainer, formalized using the UADD (Uniform Asymmetric Dialog Description) methodology created by the OP3FT. This methodology will be presented to students by the OP3FT. 3. A prototype of the virtual cross-cultural trainer.
